- Call 833-431-2053. (Operators available in multiple languages and can assist in making language/ADA accommodations)
  - 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Monday-Friday
  - 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. Saturday
- Or sign up on the [COVID-19 Vaccine Connector](#) to be contacted to schedule an appointment.
- Refugees and Immigrants can call for scheduling help in other languages: 651-318-0989, Monday-Friday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## What you need to sign up for an appointment:

- You only need to provide your first name, last name, date of birth and home address.
- You are encouraged to provide your mobile phone number and email address, if you have them.

## What you need for your appointment:

- You will be required to wear a mask and comply with social distancing requirements.
- You need to confirm your first name, last name, date of birth and home address.
- You do NOT need to provide an ID.
- You do NOT need to have medical insurance.
