Minnesota Community Vaccination Program

To sign up for a vaccine appointment you may:

- Walk-in to the site without an appointment daily from noon to 8 p.m.
- Call 833-431-2053. Operators available in multiple languages and can assist in making appointments.
- Hours open for calls:
 - Monday-Friday 9 a.m. – 7 p.m.
 - Saturday 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.
- Or sign up on the [COVID-19 Vaccine Connector \(vaccineconnector.mn.gov\)](https://vaccineconnector.mn.gov) to schedule an appointment or be contacted to schedule an appointment.
- For Refugees and Immigrants who need help making an appointment in other languages: Call 651-318-0989 Monday-Friday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m..

What you need to sign up for an appointment:

- You need to provide only your first name, last name, date of birth, and home address.
- You are encouraged to provide your mobile phone number and email address, if you have them.

What you need for your appointment:

- You are required to wear a mask and comply with social distancing requirements.
- You need to confirm your first name, last name, date of birth, and home address.
- You do NOT need to show an ID.
- You do NOT need medical insurance.
- Language interpretation and American Sign Language (ASL) will be available onsite.
- ADA accommodations available onsite.

Public transportation:

Use [Regular-Route Bus Service – Metro Transit \(www.metrotransit.org\)](https://www.metrotransit.org) to get to the State Fairgrounds.

- A free Metro Transit pass for the day of your appointment is provided in your confirmation text message and email if you register in advance.
- Metro Mobility Riders will not need a coupon or ticket for a free ride to their vaccine appointment. Book your ride as usual and tell the reservationist that this is for a vaccine appointment at the State Fairgrounds.
